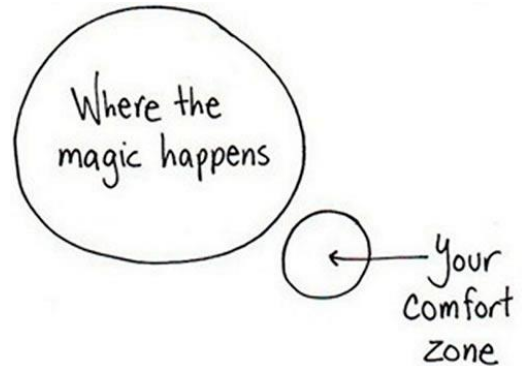


RADICAL WELCOME, TRANSFORMATIVE FAITH: Whole-Hearted Church Life & Leadership
